At the meeting a decision was also made to submit an application to Arizona Corporation Commission to change the name of the corporate entity from Chandler Community Mosque to Islamic Center of the East Valley.

ICEV is a non-profit organization formed in the mid 90s to build and operate a facility to support Islamic prayer and education located near the intersection of Alma School Road and Erie Road in Chandler. ICEV is in the process of completing construction of the building facility and is anticipated to begin operation in their own building in 2008.
