- The construction project is still on-going. The walls are completed to the full height in all but a small area. There had been some issues with the contractor and the construction activities are on hold until the issues are resolved. The issue is primarily about the availability of trade workers due to unprecedented construction activities in the valley. We hope to reach a resolution soon and carry on with the construction. - According to our plans, we are obligated to plant grown (12-ft tall) trees around the perimeter of the property. A preliminary agreement has been reached with a landscape company to plant the required trees at a cost of approximately \$500 per tree. There will be a total of 35 trees. Please note as long as anyone is benefited by the tree, the rewards will continue to accumulate for you.
